



Good Afternoon –

This email is to inform you that as of today the Town of Windsor will suspend all its public gatherings and close all indoor and outdoor recreation facilities. The decision follows an order from the Sonoma County Health Officer, out of an abundance of caution to slow the spread of the coronavirus, COVID-19. The order will be in place until it is rescinded by the Sonoma County Health Officer or State Health Officer. The suspended gatherings include the following:

- All Town of Windsor Parks & Recreation classes, programs and sports leagues
- All private rentals in Town of Windsor facilities, including outdoor sports fields and picnic areas
- Town of Windsor special events

The following Town of Windsor facilities will be closed until further notice:

- Windsor Senior Recreation Center
- Huerta Gymnasium
- Windsor Community Center
- Bluebird Center
- Town Hall and Civic Center
- Keiser Athletic Fields
- Wilson Ranch Soccer Fields

The Town of Windsor takes this situation seriously so in order to reduce potential exposure and minimize the risk to staff and the community through customer interaction, a minimal level of staffing will be maintained to ensure the delivery of essential services.

For customers of recreation programs, classes and rentals cancelled, refunds will be processed and issued upon the return to full-service levels.

Staff will continue to monitor the status of COVID-19 and send out additional information to patrons where necessary related to Town of Windsor Parks & Recreation programming and facilities. Additional information on COVID-19 can be found at the following link:
